5	<p>Pre-Raphaelites and narrative painting study/ biography, following Lady Lever visit. Rossetti, Waterhouse.</p> <p>Post- impressionist still life with fruit/ flowers, Cezanne.</p>	<p>Chagall. Look at repeating themes, collect ideas, small group, large scale mixed media images.</p> <p>Observational drawings- bicycles: pencil, chalk, charcoal, paint, pen and ink.</p>	<p>Romero Britto, icons, Pop Art.</p> <p>Colour wheels.</p> <p>Design and make heraldic shields to represent own families, interests etc.</p>
6	<p>Bayeux Tapestry images to tell the true story of the battle of Hastings.</p> <p>Portrait painting after Hilliard and Holbein. Compare/ contrast with modern work of Christian Furr.</p> <p>Calligraphy in pen and ink linked to Shackleton diaries.</p>	<p>Picasso, Braque and Cubism. Mixed media portraits using a limited palette. Guernica.</p> <p>Gustav Klimt- life size whole people, collage.</p>	<p>Aztec calendar wheels and day of the dead 'sugar skull' masks.</p> <p>Photography/ biography of Ansel Adams.</p> <p>Watercolour landscape paintings 'en plein air'</p>
