

## **Relationship & Sex Education (RSE) Consultation with parents**

The consultation questions were as follows:

3. Are there any changes or additions that you think should be made to the RSE Policy?

This consultation enabled school to review RSE and how it is taught in school. As a result of the consultation, it was agreed that parents would be informed through additional content on the website.
